Menstrual Health Workshops

We were delighted to welcome the organisation, 'Bloody Amazing' to Bankhead Primary recently. They delivered workshops to our P6 and P7 girls. Survey data indicated that 89% of P6s found the session useful and 100% of P7 girls found the input useful. As a result of the workshops, we have formed a working party of P6 and P7 girls to create a period policy for Bankhead Primary.
